Q: How do I know if I am depressed?

Depression is a serious medical illness that involves the brain. It's more than just a feeling of being "down in the dumps" for a few days. The feelings do not go away. They persist and interfere with your everyday life. Symptoms can include sadness, loss of interest in activities you used to enjoy, weight gain or loss. A person can have loss of energy and sleep difficulties. It can even include thoughts of death. Depression often runs in families and is much more common in women. Women can also get postpartum depression. Some people get Seasonal Affective Disorder in the winter. Iowa has long and sunless winters, so SAD is very common. There are effective treatments for depression including medications and talk therapy.
